WHAT THE JUDGE SAW

- A Presentation by Ben Pike

Ben Pike has enormous gratitude to J P Brown, a teacher at his school, who first taught him how to develop and print black and white 35mm film. This gave him a lifetime interest in photography. Now thirty something years later, he retains a love for all things photographic. He has an extensive photography library which he finds invaluable to dip into for inspiration or research - Mortensen to Adams, Bresson to Matt Stuart and many others.



Ben's personal interest is exploration photography; he likes to explore the world with a camera, whether on the street, in the countryside, or in the macro world.



When critiquing other's photographs, he says he always aims to view the whole image and understand the purpose rather than just the technical. Every image presented is personal and important to the author and that should always be respected. From a snapshot to a fine art image, all represent part of the spectrum of photography.

Tonight's lecture is an interactive talk on camera club judges; how they see your images, how to avoid common pitfalls when entering competitions at club level and how to improve your mark. This includes approximately 20 images from past competition entries.
