- A Presentation by Jane Goodall


Thursday, 9 April 2026 at 7:30 for 8pm

In addition to being a cardiovascular research scientist, Jane Goodall is a keen photographer and a judge for the East Anglian Federation of photographers. Originally from Didcot, she traded the open skies of the Chilterns for the wind swept Fenland landscape that has been her home for the last 25 years.



Inspired by the natural landscape and captivated by the fleeting moments of changing light and tides, she has been drawn to the British coast; regions that include Dorset, Cornwall, Northumbria

and the Scottish islands. Her recent work focuses on local scenes, from the majestic misty views of geese on the Kings College lawn, old rusting diesel pumps hiding amongst the nettles in the fenland, and the local fauna and woodlands.



Jane's landscape presentation demonstrates how she works with light for maximum impact, using perspective and visual cues to create compelling images. She explores the psychology of seeing and explains why understanding how the human brain interprets a scene can make a crucial difference to the success of photographs. She also charts

her progression in landscape photography through evolving methods of presentation, moving beyond the traditional flat image to more immersive ways of showing the work.
